CALL FOR STUDENT POSTER PRESENTATION SESSION SUBMISSION NOW OPEN!

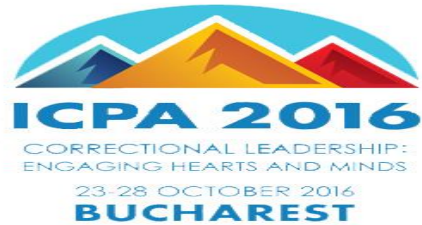
The ICPA Programme Committee and The **Faculty of Sociology and Social Work (FSSW), University of Bucharest** cordially invites submissions from postgraduate and undergraduate students interested in presenting their research at the upcoming poster presentation session of the Association's 2016 Annual Conference. The theme of our 18th Annual Conference is '**Correctional Leadership: Engaging Hearts and Minds**' in Bucharest, hosted by the **National Administration of Penitentiaries**, and held at the Radisson Blu Hotel, from **October 23rd – 28th, 2016**. The student poster presentation session aims to allow student researchers a unique opportunity to present their research and engage with corrections leaders from around the world and will take place on Wednesday, 26th of October, 2016, between 11.00 and 12.30, Alcyone conference room.

The Programme Committee welcomes proposals for poster presentations from students on any topic related to corrections. The ICPA Conference is the foremost annual international gathering for senior correctional officials to 'learn from each other' and from the academic community. The ICPA Programme Committee consequently extends an invitation to student researchers to submit ideas for presentations relating to the general theme or any other theme with direct relevance to correctional practice, administration, or management.

Faculty of Sociology and Social Work (FSSW), University of Bucharest is ICPA's partner for organizing the student poster session for **ICPA CONFERENCE 2016**.

The poster session is an ideal opportunity for students to be involved in the ICPA Annual Conference. Posters will be prominently displayed during the conference and a formal poster session will be scheduled (during which we ask authors to stand with their posters to answer questions and engage in discussions with interested attendees). Conference registration fees for the day of presentation will be waived for all student presenters allowing them to attend presentation sessions on that day.

Please ensure that the email Subject Line includes the following: **ICPA Student Submission**.

Your submission should include:

- Title;
- Authors (please note that multiple authors are acceptable but the first author must be a student) – please also include the university and/or institutional affiliation for each author;
- Contact Information for Lead Author (name, email address);
- **ABSTRACT** (400 words maximum);
- Three keywords describing the research.

Please note that with **the exception of the registration fee waiver**, student presenters will be required to cover all other expenses associated with the conference, travel and accommodation costs.
