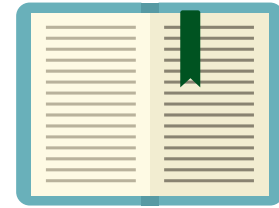

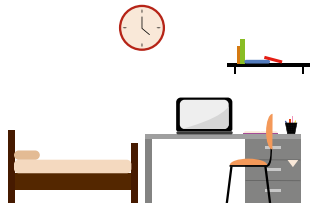

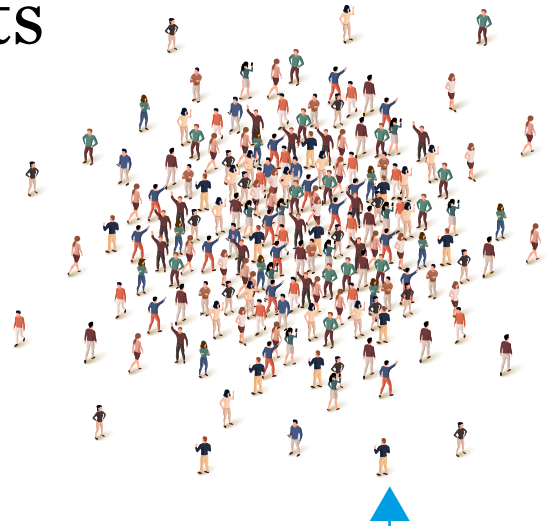

1. Gabs = general average in BA graduation exam ( $1/2$ Mid years of studies +  $1/2$ Bachelor's degree: 2)
2. Gessay = Grade awarded by the commission for the essay submitted at the time of registration.
3. Ginterview = Grade awarded by the Commission for the interview
